GINGER FIKES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Ginger Fikes Scholarship Fund was established by the family and friends of Ginger Fikes, who lost her life on July 5, 1996, when she was a passenger in a car hit from behind by a drunk driver. Ginger would have been a 1997 graduate of Center Point High School.

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. Applicant must be a graduating student in good standing at Center Point High School.
3. Applicant should be active in extracurricular activities, community service and have better than average grades.
4. Applicant must write a **brief essay on the consequences of drinking and driving and the best way to stop this problem (500 words or less). Must attach to online scholarship application.**
5. Applicant must be accepted into an accredited college or university (public or private) prior to any scholarship funds being sent to the college or university.
6. Applicant must be considered as a full time student by the college or university he/she attends before scholarship funds are released for the benefit of the Applicant.
7. Scholarship Funds can be utilized for tuition, books or boarding expenses.
8. The Scholarship may be used for any field of interest of the Applicant for first year studies.
9. If accepted, scholarship must be claimed within one year or it will be terminated.
10. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

Application deadline is 12 noon, January 24, 2018

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted
