Rhett Urban was a 1992 graduate of Comfort High School. Known for his infectious smile and keen sense of humor, Rhett never met a stranger. He loved sports, especially baseball, football and snow skiing. Most of all, Rhett loved people. He treasured his friends and they treasured him. Rhett died tragically in an automobile accident shortly after graduation.

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. The Rhett Urban Memorial Scholarship is a onetime payout award.
3. Applicant must be a current graduating senior from Comfort High School or a graduate of Comfort High School who is enrolled at an accredited college, university or trade school.
4. Applicant must be considered a full time student by the college he/she attends.
5. Applicant must be accepted in an accredited college/university or trade school prior to completion of the award process.
6. Each recipient should be able to provide a list of extracurricular activities; community and volunteer work; and honors and awards.
7. Each recipient should exemplify good character, integrity, responsibility and leadership.
8. Upon completion of the application a qualified applicant may be requested to appear for a personal interview with the Community Foundation Scholarship Committee.
9. If accepted, scholarship must be claimed within one year or it will be terminated.
10. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

Application deadline is 12 noon, January 24, 2018

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted
