SABINAL CIVIC CLUB SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. Graduating college-bound Sabinal ISD High School seniors OR a college-bound senior student receiving education at home through a state-approved curriculum and residing in the Sabinal area, and enrolled or planning to enroll in the Southwest Texas Junior College System (SWJTC). The senior must have participated in community service throughout high school and plan to continue to participate in community service through college. Any college bound senior may apply.
3. The students must describe how they plan to use the scholarship, the degree and career path they have determined for themselves, their community service contributions during high school and how they plan to continue conducting community service in college, and they must describe their successes in school and involvement in extracurricular activities.
4. Special provision: If a student received the scholarship for their first year of college, they may re-apply for it the next consecutive calendar year to assist with tuition for their sophomore year. This must be based on need, and a transcript of their freshman year must be attached to the application.
5. If the Sabinal Civic Club should ever disband or be unable to conduct its duties, The Community Foundation shall ensure that the scholarship is distributed and the Foundation should seek input from another Sabinal-area nonprofit organization to select the winners. (Lions Club, Methodist Church Board of Directors, etc.).
6. An individual student cannot be awarded the Ann Pierce Memorial Scholarship and the Sabinal Civic Club Scholarship in the same year.
7. The scholarship award is null and void if not used within one year of the award date.
8. Application (with all request attachments) must be complete to be considered.

Application deadline is 12 noon, January 24, 2018

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted
