Miriam E. Kay Memorial Scholarship Guidelines

Miriam E. Kay was a life-long educator. She taught children and adults all over the world. Mrs. Kay firmly believed in the transforming power of education over hardship. Her legacy is to help the dream of a college education become a reality for young people with her passion for learning.

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. The purpose of this scholarship award is to encourage or assist a young Hispanic man or woman to pursue a college degree. Applicant must be a Hispanic student and must submit a high school transcript showing designation.
3. Applicant must be a current graduating student of Tivy High School, Comfort High School, Center Point High School, Ingram Tom Moore High School, Harper High School or Our Lady of the Hills Catholic High School.
4. Applicant must be accepted into a two year or four year accredited college or university (public or private) prior to any scholarship funds being sent to the college or university.
5. Applicant must be considered as a full time student by the college or university she/he attends before scholarship funds are released for the benefit of the Applicant.
6. Scholarship funds can be utilized for tuition, books or boarding expenses.
7. The Miriam E. Kay Memorial Scholarship is a four-year renewable award provided that the recipient maintains a minimum of a 3.0 GPA. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to provide the Community Foundation with a copy of an official college transcript of his or her grades each year in order to be considered for successive years.
8. Upon completion of the application, a qualified applicant may be requested to appear for a personal interview with the scholarship committee.
9. If accepted, scholarship must be claimed within one year or it will be terminated.
10. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

Application deadline is 12 noon, January 24, 2018

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted
