### **ANN PIERCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

*Ann Pierce was a third generation active member of the Sabinal Civic Club for many years. She bequeathed part of her estate to the Sabinal Civic Club because she believed in the power of its impact on the community. Ms. Pierce was the daughter of artist Hallie Beth Willingham Pierce. She grew up traveling the world with her military father and artist mother. She lived abroad most of her maturational years but, when her father retired from the military, she moved with her parents to Sabinal. After her death, the Sabinal Civic Club established a scholarship in her name.*

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at [www.communityfoundation.net](http://www.communityfoundation.net).
2. Graduating college-bound or trade school-bound Sabinal ISD High School seniors OR a college-bound or trade school-bound senior student receiving education at home through a state-approved curriculum and residing in the Sabinal area. The senior must have participated in community service throughout high school and plan to continue to participate in community service through college.
3. The applicant must describe how the scholarship will be used, the degree and career path they have determined for themselves, their community service contributions during high school and how they plan to continue conducting community service in college, and they must describe their successes in school and involvement in extracurricular activities.
4. Special provision: If a student received the scholarship for their first year of college, they may re-apply for it the next consecutive calendar year to assist with tuition for their sophomore year. This must be based on need, and a transcript of their freshman year must be attached to the application.
5. The scholarship will be awarded in two separate semester payments – for the second/spring semester payment to be issued, the student must submit proof of their first semester passing grades to the Community Foundation.
6. If the Sabinal Civic Club should ever disband or be unable to conduct its duties, The Community Foundation shall ensure the scholarship is distributed and the Foundation should seek input from another Sabinal-area nonprofit organization to select the winners. (Lions Club, Methodist Church Board of Directors, etc.).
7. An individual student cannot be awarded the Ann Pierce Memorial Scholarship and the Sabinal Civic Club Scholarship in the same year.
8. The scholarship award is null and void if not used within one year of the award date.
9. Application (with all request attachments) must be complete to be considered.
