

CAPTAIN MARK TYLER VOSS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Captain Mark Tyler Voss Memorial Scholarship was established with the Community Foundation of the Texas Hill Country to provide scholarships for graduating students from a high school in Boerne ISD. Captain Mark Tyler Voss was a 2004 graduate of Boerne High School. He died at the age of 28 while serving in the Air Force in Afghanistan as a pilot with the 93rd Air Refueling Squadron.

- 1. Each applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
- 2. Each recipient must be a current graduating senior from a high school in Boerne ISD.
- 3. Each recipient must have a GPA that ranks the student in the top quarter of his/her class.
- 4. Each recipient must be considered a full time student by the college he/she attends.
- 5. Applicant must be accepted in an accredited college/university or trade school prior to the completion of the award process.
- 6. Each recipient should be able to provide a list of extracurricular activities; community and volunteer work; and honors and awards, as well as an essay demonstrating passion for a field of study.
- 7. Each recipient should exemplify good character, integrity, responsibility and leadership.
- 8. Upon completion of the Community Foundation Scholarship Application, a qualified applicant may be requested to appear for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.
- 9. Each scholarship is a one-time award. Recipients may not reapply for the scholarship.
- 10. If accepted, scholarship must be claimed within one year or it will be terminated.
- 11. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS 12 NOON, JANUARY 25, 2019

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted
