THE FRANTZEN-RINKER BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Frantzen-Rinker Business Scholarship was established for students pursuing an undergraduate/graduate business degree with a substantial business emphasis at an accredited college/university offering classes at Hill Country University Center.

1. The applicant must complete the Community Foundation of the Texas Hill Country's scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. Applicants must be enrolled in, be graduating from, be a graduate of a Gillespie County public or private high school, **OR** be a resident of Gillespie, Kerr, Kendall, Kimble, Mason, Llano or Blanco Counties with an intent to pursue an undergraduate/graduate business degree (finance, accounting, organizational management, communication, marketing, etc.) at an accredited college/university offering classes at Hill Country University Center, 2818 East U.S. Hwy. 290, Fredericksburg, Texas.
3. Applicants must have financial need as determined by the Hill Country University Center Scholarship Committee.
4. Applicants must have at least a 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 Grade Point Average scale or have a passing score on Texas Success Initiative (TSI) or an equivalent college readiness test.
5. Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) hours per semester at an accredited college/university offering classes at Hill Country University Center, 2818 East U.S. Hwy. 290, Fredericksburg, Texas.
6. Applicants must include an essay explaining why the applicant should be considered for the scholarship and what impact the scholarship would have on the applicant (350 words or less).
7. Recipients may reapply for the scholarship providing they are attending and are in good standing with an accredited college/university offering classes at Hill Country University Center, 2818 East U.S. Hwy. 290, Fredericksburg, Texas.
8. The scholarship award is null and void if not used within one year of the award date.
9. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS 12 NOON, JANUARY 25, 2019

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted
