THE KAROLYN KOLB MARTINEZ "EXCELLENCE IN NURSING" MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Karolyn was a Registered Nurse for thirty-two years, providing compassionate and Christ-centered care to her patients. After graduating with an ADN and BSN, the majority of her career was spent in the Emergency Department and as a SANE (Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner). At the time of her death, she was enrolled in a Nursing Education graduate program. Karolyn was passionate about educating nurses and those working to become nurses. Karolyn's family honors her legacy by providing the opportunity of nursing education to scholarship applicants who display the same high standards for nursing excellence, care and compassion that she demonstrated.

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. Applicant must be seeking an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) or a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (BSN) and/or enrolled in LVN or RN nursing programs at Schreiner University or Alamo Colleges.
3. Applicant must be a current graduating senior from Kerrville Independent School District seeking a nursing degree at either Schreiner University or Alamo Colleges OR a student currently pursuing a nursing degree at either Schreiner University or Alamo Colleges.
4. Before the scholarship amount can be applied to the student's account, a recipient must be enrolled in Schreiner University's Nursing program or Alamo College's Nursing program and must be considered a full time student.
5. An individual who has been awarded an initial scholarship by the Karolyn Kolb Martinez "Excellence in Nursing" Memorial Scholarship Fund may reapply in successive years provided the recipient maintains a minimum 2.5 GPA. Each successive year, the recipient must reapply for the scholarship online by the deadline date and attach a letter outlining the recipient's continued need and qualification for assistance, along with proof of grades attained. They will then be considered for the scholarship award along with other qualified applicants. An award in one year is neither a guarantee of an award in the future or an indication the recipient will be given preference over other applicants in future years.
6. Upon completion of the application, a qualified applicant may be requested to appear for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.
7. If accepted, scholarship must be claimed within one year or it will be terminated.
8. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS 12 NOON, JANUARY 25, 2019

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted

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
