

THE LOUELLA BEAZLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

After seeing her stepson struggle while studying to become a doctor, Mrs. Louella Beazley set up this fund for students graduating from Kerr County to assist them in their pursuit of a degree in the medical field.

- 1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
- 2. The Louella W. Beazley Memorial Scholarship is a four-year renewable award provided that the recipient maintains a minimum of a 3.0 GPA. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to provide the Community Foundation with proof (an official college transcript) of his or her grades each year in order to be considered for the next years' award.
- 3. Each recipient <u>must</u> be a current graduating senior in **Kerr County**.
- 4. Each recipient <u>must</u> have at least a 3.0 grade point average for consideration.
- 5. Applicants <u>must</u> be considered a full time student by the college he/she attends.
- 6. Applicants <u>must</u> be accepted in an accredited college/university with a field of study of *Medical or Nursing* prior to completion of the award process
- 7. Each recipient <u>should</u> be able to provide a list of extracurricular activities; community and volunteer work; and honors and awards.
- 8. Each recipient should exemplify good character, integrity, responsibility and leadership.
- 9. Upon completion of the application a qualified applicant <u>may</u> be requested to appear for a personal interview with the Community Foundation Scholarship Committee.
- 10. If accepted, the scholarship must be claimed within one year or it will be terminated.
- 11. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS 12 NOON, JANUARY 25, 2019

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted
