1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior from Bandera, Blanco, Comal, Gillespie, Kendall or Kerr County or a prior graduate of a high school in Bandera, Blanco, Comal, Gillespie, Kendall or Kerr County.
3. Applicant must be pursuing a criminal justice degree, e.g., law enforcement, criminal investigations, corrections, criminal psychology, forensic science, homeland security, etc.
4. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled in a related institution, academy or university before the scholarship amount can be paid to the institution, academy or university.
5. Upon completion of the application, a qualified applicant may be requested to appear for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.
6. If accepted, scholarship must be claimed within one year or it will be terminated.
7. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS 12 NOON, JANUARY 25, 2019
