If you are a recipient of this scholarship, you are being given a hand up because of him, in order to build a solid foundation in your chosen field. Please follow your given talents and interests and apply yourself to build that foundation.

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net and submit with requested attachments.
2. The applicant must be a graduating senior from Comfort High School or a graduate of Comfort High School who is enrolling/enrolled in an accredited college, university or trade school.
3. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States.
4. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
5. Applicant should exemplify good character, integrity, and responsibility.
6. Applicant must provide recommendations from two (2) teachers or a recommendation from one (1) teacher, as well as a recommendation from the Comfort High School Counselor.
7. Applicant must exhibit financial need as determined by the Advisory Selection Committee.
8. Although this scholarship is intended to be awarded annually, the Advisory Selection Committee has the authority not to award a scholarship in a year for which there are no qualifying candidates under the guidelines established.
9. The scholarship award is null and void if not used within one year of the award date.
