SETNAN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FUND GUIDELINES

*The Setnan Family Scholarship Fund was established with the Community Foundation of the Texas Hill Country to provide scholarships for **qualified African American young men and women** from Kerrville, Texas who might not have the opportunity of pursuing a higher education without additional financial assistance.*

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. Applicant must be an African American student and must submit a high school transcript showing designation.
3. Applicant must be a member of a church and attend church services on a regular basis **confirmed with a letter from the pastor of that church (Must be attached to online scholarship application)**.
4. Each applicant should exemplify good character, integrity, responsibility and leadership, and he or she should be committed to the pursuit of a higher education.
5. Applicant must be a current graduating senior from the Tivy High School District, or one who has attained a GED in Kerrville within the last year.
6. Applicant must have a 2.25 - 4.0 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) or he or she must have scored at a comparable level on her GED to be considered for an award.
7. Applicant must be accepted in an accredited college/university or technical school prior to completion of the award process. Distribution will be made directly to the institution.
8. Applicant must be considered a full time student by the institution he or she plans to attend.
9. **An application must be accompanied by a one page cover letter outlining the reasons the applicant should be considered as an award candidate (Must be attached to online scholarship application).**
10. Upon receipt of a completed application, The Awards Committee may request a qualified candidate to appear for a personal interview.
11. An individual who has been awarded an initial scholarship by the SF *SCHOLARSHIP FUND* may submit a request for an additional scholarship in each of the following three years, provided that the recipient maintains a minimum of 2.25 - 4.0 GPA. Each year, the recipient must reapply for the scholarship online at www.communityfoundation.net by the deadline date and attach a letter outlining the recipient's continued need and qualification for assistance along with proof of grades attained (an official college transcript). The student will then be considered along with other qualified applicants for an additional award that year.
12. If accepted, scholarship must be claimed within one year or it will be terminated.
13. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS 12 NOON, JANUARY 25, 2019

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted
