SIERRA PHILLIPS-HESS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Sierra Phillips-Hess Memorial Scholarship was established with the Community Foundation of the Texas Hill Country to provide scholarships to graduating students from Fredericksburg High School who have participated in the HOSA (Health Occupational Student Association) Program. Sierra was a much loved student at Fredericksburg High School who was very active in the HOSA Program.

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. Applicant must be a current graduating senior from Fredericksburg High School.
3. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average for consideration.
4. Applicant must be considered a full time student by the college he/she attends.
5. Applicant must be accepted in an accredited college/university or trade school prior to completion of the award process.
6. Applicant should be able to provide a list of extracurricular activities; community and volunteer work; and honors and awards.
7. Each recipient should exemplify good character, integrity, responsibility and leadership.
8. Upon completion of the Community Foundation Scholarship Application a qualified applicant may be requested to appear for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.
9. An individual who has been awarded an initial scholarship by the **SIERRA PHILLIPS-HESS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND** may submit a request for an additional scholarship in each of the following three years, provided the recipient maintains a minimum of a 2.0 GPA. Each year, the recipient must reapply for the scholarship online at www.communityfoundation.net by the deadline date and attach a letter outlining the recipient's continued need and qualification for assistance along with proof of grades attained (college transcript). The student will then be considered along with other qualified applicants for an additional award that year.
10. If accepted, scholarship must be claimed within one year or it will be terminated.
11. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS 12 NOON, JANUARY 25, 2019

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted

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
