WINDOW OF OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Window of Opportunity Scholarship was established to help provide educational funds for graduating students at Fredericksburg ISD who have participated in the Fredericksburg Academic Boosters Mentoring Program for two years prior to their senior year or who are ranked in the bottom 50% of their graduating class.

1. The applicant must complete the scholarship application online at www.communityfoundation.net.
2. Applicant must be a United States citizen.
3. Applicant must be a graduating senior from Fredericksburg High School or Fredericksburg High School Alternative School or a graduate of Fredericksburg High School or Fredericksburg High School Alternative School.
4. Applicant must meet above requirements plus have ONE of the following requirements:
 - a. Any student who has participated in the Fredericksburg Academic Boosters Mentoring Program for 2 years prior to the student's senior year of high school without consideration of their high school ranking
OR
 - b. A student who is/was ranked in the bottom 50% of the student's graduating class at Fredericksburg High School or Fredericksburg High School Alternative School.
5. An applicant who has been awarded an initial scholarship by the Window of Opportunity Scholarship Fund may reapply in successive years, provided the recipient maintains a minimum 2.5 GPA. Each year, the recipient must reapply for the scholarship online at www.communityfoundation.net by the deadline date and attach a letter outlining the recipient's continued need and qualification for assistance, along with proof of grades attained (college transcript). The student will then be considered along with other qualified applicants in that scholarship cycle.
6. The scholarship award is null and void if not used within one year of the award date.
7. Application (with all requested attachments) must be complete to be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS 12 NOON, JANUARY 25, 2019

All applications must be completed online; no paper submissions will be accepted
